NVSL 2014 Rule Changes

Each year the NVSL has a Rules Meeting. In most years, a lot of these involve technical changes that have been insignificant to most meets. This year, on Sunday March 30 there were two rule changes that affect our parents or swimmers directly.

These rule changes relate to the Standards of Conduct which can be viewed on the NVSL site at the <u>Document Center</u>

These amendments which passed included:

• Amending bullet #3 of the Standards of Conduct to include "social media". This bullet states "avoid using inappropriate language, profanity, humiliating or intimidating remarks or behavior (including through social media), verbal or physical assault toward an athlete, coach, team representative, official, NVSL leadership or spectator"

- Amendment to rule 1b Dealing with Standards of Conduct to list some of the violations for which sanctions may be applied. Included in the amendment as examples are:
- trespassing on or damaging the property of any NVSL pool;
- setting off any incendiary devices at any time at any NVSL pool property on the day of any NVSL meet
- any depictions of personal injury or death directed at team representatives, coaches, swimmers or team mascots.

These illustrative examples of unacceptable conduct are not intended to be exhaustive.

GATOR Parents and Swimmers – Let's make sure that we display good sportsmanship at ALL TIMES while at our pool in our interactions with each other ALL coaches, volunteers, officials, parents and swimmers of our own team and other teams.

NVSL Standards of Conduct

The NVSL Standards of Conduct are found on our website under NVSL Standards and as mentioned on the NVSL site. Please take a look at these – and abide by them as true Gators during 2014! Good sportsmanship is good for the team and the league! Lead by example! Once again you'll be asked to confirm you will abide by these during registration!

Gator Leadership Primer

The Gator Swim Team operates as an organization within the Forest Hollow Swim Club. The Swim Team Representative (also known as the A-Meet Rep or Team Rep) is an officer of the Forest Hollow Swim Club and serves a three year term, similar to other Forest Hollow Swim Club board positions. The Team Rep is elected by the Gator team parents through a process developed and articulated by the Swim

Forest Hollow Gators 2014 Spring Newsletter Page 3 Team Board. The Board is led by the Team Rep with positions for the key leaders for the team. Specifically, the Board positions are **generally** the key volunteer leaders, including: Team Rep(s); most recent former Team Rep; B-Meet Rep; Treasurer; leads for Merchandise, Concessions, Volunteers and Data. Each year, the Gator Guide (also known as the Handbook) articulates the process for volunteer positions and the board election process.

The Gator board leadership positions are volunteer positions that historically run three-year terms. Some people choose to serve less than a three year term, some choose to enter a second – full or partial – term. When a volunteer has expressed and interest to transition out or is at the end of their commitment, interest for open positions are communicated to the swim team parents, via newsletters, weekly updates, volunteer signups, and word-ofmouth, including pep rallies.

Some positions require "advance" notification/planning as they require some training or shadowing to take on the task. This is primarily the Team Rep position, as many of the duties also involve NVSL processes, but merchandise, data, and concessions positions all benefit from at least shadowing the prior volunteer. These types of positions are easier to learn with some guidance than on one's own.

In most years, we have to do a little "pushing" and "pulling" to get people to step into the rolls – especially the Team Rep positions given the time commitment involved. But, some years, we have had greater interest in a position. In years where we only get one person to answer the call, we fill the position with that person with no election held. In years where the interest is larger, we schedule a vote for the position, normally at the year–end awards banguet or other pre–announced time.

Hopefully, this article has helped you understand the process and the leadership positions. There are several other articles <u>Register online by May 1 to get</u> <u>your FREE t-shirt and swim cap.</u> Otherwise a \$5 per shirt and \$3 per cap will be charged while

2014 Gator Merchandise

Cara Dalrymple continues as our 2014 Merchandising Rep! She has been busy working with our Sport Fair rep to get us all ready for this season. We will have newly designed swim caps, t-shirts and hoodies.

The summer suit will remain the same as



2013 since it is a two year Speedo Suit that wears very well. Gators will be hitting the pool once again in Speedo Vortex (Female all sizes \$57.75 and Male all sizes \$37.28 pricing includes tax). The suits will be on sale at the parent meeting WEDNESDAY, May

28) at the beginning of the season. Suits can also be purchased at Sports Fair in Arlington, VA.

This suit is made of special fabric - that is long lasting - but doesn't stretch like normal suits. We highly recommend that each swimmer try on the suit at the team meeting or at Sports Fair to get the right fit.

Note: A team suit is NOT required, but it is highly encouraged. It helps promote team unity and spirit and it looks great in our team picture. Gators of all ages like to be part of the team – having the Gator



suit helps them be part of the team.

As part of your team fees each swimmer will receive a t-shirt (guaranteed and receive special pricing on only one order. Thus, it is imperative if you Gator wants a t-shirt in a particular size, to REGISTER by MAY 1! It is online and it is easy. Extra adult t-shirts are also only available through ordering at the time of registration.

FREE of cost IF you register by May 1). If you register after May 1, and while our "extra supplies last" you will be charged a mandatory \$5 fee for the t-shirt, no exceptions! Please understand the t-shirt process is labor intensive and one. We will have the same swim cap as last season. Every swimmer, registering by May 1 will receive a cap for FREE. Those that register

after May 1 will be charged \$3. Our supply of older caps from prior years will be on sale as practice caps. This year's cap design but in silicone can be purchased for \$10 and ordered pre-season when you register your swimmer.

Other merchandising options will be available in 2014. Ms. Dalrymple will be working to offer some great options for fun, for Gator Buddy gifts, and for styling Gator pride around the community! Look for news and updates on the website and through notifications as these options become available!

Register for the Club & Gators

Registration in 2014 is EASY - both for **RETURNING team members and our NEW** team members!

You'll find links to the Swim Club, Swim Team, and Mini Gator Pre-season Lessons. Click on the registration link and the system will guide you through.

If you are a returning member (you registered in 2013 for the team), then use your same "user name" (likely your e-mail address) and register as an "existing member". If you've forgotten your password, there is a link at the bottom of the page to lead you to a reset process. If vou have problems, you can always e-mail the Team Reps and we can walk you through or find your "user name". The biggest benefit you'll find as a returning member – your key information only needs

to be updated, it is already populated into the system!

If you are a new swim team member, you simply need to register as a "new" member, enter a "user name" (suggest your e-mail) and a password you can remember. The system will walk you through some easy screens for getting your kids enrolled.

Registrations for the Swim Club and the Swim Team are separate – that means you'll have to register for the Swim Club separate from the Swim Team. Mini Gator lessons are also under a separate registration. But, once you've signed in, your same name and password will work.

For the Swim Team, all registrations are online – we don't take your checks! You'll have two options to pay – debit/credit or e– check. We encourage you to use e–check if you can as the fees are lower, giving more back to the team.

For the Swim Club, you can register online or pay the traditional way by filling out a hand form and paying by check. We strongly encourage you to register online! Why? You can either pay by debit/credit card or e-check, just like for swim team, but you can also click an option to mail in your payment by mail.

The glory is – you can easily fill out the information electronically and it is part of Forest Hollow's data base. E-mail notifications about pool closings and other news will come from this data base. So try something new and register online for both the Swim Team (required) and the Swim Club!

GATOR FACTS.....

WHO ARE THE GATORS?

The Gators are boys and girls (and their parents) who are members of the Forest Hollow Swim Team. Our team focuses on improving swimming skills, learning good sportsmanship and self-discipline. We have daily practices, compete in swim meets, have family potluck dinners and pep rallies on Friday nights, make new friends and have lots of fun!!

WHO CAN JOIN?

The swim team is open to swimmers, ages 4 – 18. Gators must be able to swim at least 50 meters (2 pool lengths) continuously, without assistance. Gators will work on stroke technique, starts, turns and endurance during practice and participate in swim meets.

Mini Gators must be comfortable in the water (can fully submerge head for 5 seconds), propel themselves for a short distance in the pool, be able to follow directions, work well in a group and leave parents willingly.

The goal of the Mini Gator program is to provide young swimmers with the basic swimming skills necessary for the continued involvement in competitive swimming. Please check out our Mini Gator Guide on the website for more information about whether your child is ready to be a Mini Gator or ready to be a Gator!

WHEN DO GATORS SWIM?

The 2014 Swim season for Gators begins with our Team Kickoff meeting on Wednesday, May 28, 2014. Practice begins on Thursday, May 29 and ends Friday, July 26. The season is extended to Aug. 3 for those who make it to individual All Stars.

2014 Practice Sessions

May 29 through June 24 – Lane Swimmers only – evening practice

June 25 – July 25 Monday through Friday morning and Tuesday/Thursday evening available for Gators unable to attend the morning practice. Mini Gators morning practice – June 25 through July 25, 2014. Tuesday and Thursday evenings are available for Mini Gators unable to attend the morning practice.

Regular attendance at practice and meets is encouraged. Please note: Nighttime practice is shared with pool patrons so space is limited. Plus, there are more evening thunderstorms that may disrupt practice.

2014 Swim Meets

Saturday mornings A Meets (NVSL league meets). Monday evening B Meets (developmental meets).

All swimmers are encouraged to swim at the developmental meets. Participating in league or Saturday morning meets is limited and selections are made based on specific criteria (see Gator Guide).

The <u>Meet Schedule</u> can be found online on our website.

Specific practice times are online under <u>PRACTICE TIMES.</u>

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

- \$102 for 1 swimmer
- \$93 for the 2nd swimmer
- \$86 for each additional swimmer.

Registration fees help to pay for the coaching staff, equipment, ribbons, awards and team activities. Each swimmer registered by May 1 will receive a free team t-shirt and latex swim cap. Swimmers registered after May 1 are not guaranteed a T-shirt or latex cap; the mandatory cost for these items after May 1 is \$5 for the t-shirt and \$3 for the latex cap - while supplies last. No exceptions! Over the past several summers, the Gators have offered our Mini Gator swimmers a pre-season opportunity to get in the water before Mini swimming begins on June 25. These lessons are offered for a two week period – Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/ Thursday for 30 minutes each over a two week period. Each registered swimmer gets FOUR pre-season sessions.

For 2014, we are once again offering these lessons. But, registration is online ONLY. We must have a minimum of 4 swimmers registered and we can take no more than 6 swimmers for each session.

Information explaining additional details, costs, etc is on the website. The costs remain steady, although a transaction fee is added for the online registration process. Should we need to cancel the session, you will be refunded the cost (not the transaction fee) as disclosed on the registration page. Remember – this is pre–season and the weather can at times be challenging. Makeup days if necessary will be communicated. Should we not be able to hold these, we would refund on a pro–rata basis.

Gator Only Information on Website

The swim team provides information about the team we'd prefer not to share with the public but which is accessible to our swimmers and parents. This includes team photos and swimmers' times. In order to secure this information we display it on a webpage that requires the site visitor to login. Therefore, in order to gain access to the page you will need an account.

To register for the site, look in the left sidebar, near the bottom of any page. Click, 'register' and create an account with a Username, Email and Password. All accounts will be checked against the swim team roster before they are approved.

Once approved, simply login to see private gator content. Links to swimmer times and photos will appear in the gator menu on the left of every page. If you aren't logged in, those links won't appear. Please remember, this account is for access to private Swim Team information only. You do not need an account to access most of the site, and this account is not related to your account for paying dues.
